

Students

Health, Eye, and Dental Examinations; Immunizations; and Exclusion of Students

It shall be the responsibility of each member school district of residence to ensure that all resident students comply with all applicable laws pertaining to health examinations and immunization schedules.

If a student attending a Cooperative class or program fails to comply with such laws, the District Superintendent or designee shall notify the Executive Director or designee to exclude said student from public school attendance until further notice.

Homeless Child

Any homeless child shall be immediately admitted, even if the child or child's parent/guardian is unable to produce immunization and health records normally required for enrollment.
